Indicator Definition and How it was Calculated:

**Persistence** is defined by percent of students who enrolled in at least one of the next two sessions after their initial enrollment in the 2018/2019 academic year.

**Retention** is defined by percent of students who enrolled in the next academic year (2019/2020) after their initial enrollment in the 2018/2019 academic year.

**Graduation rate** is defined by the number of 2011/2012 new students who completed their degree (BBA/PM or MBA/PM) with Amberton within 8 years. Both programs started in the 2011/2012 academic year.
